# Tdap and Tdap-IPV Product Updates

## New Product: Boostrix-IPV®

Ontario's publicly funded Tdap-IPV vaccine now includes Boostrix-IPV®. You may receive either Adacel-IPV® or Boostrix-IPV® based on stock availability and expiry date. Adacel-IPV® and Boostrix-IPV® both protect against diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, and polio. The Tdap-IPV vaccine is routinely given in Ontario to children 4-6 years of age.

- Boostrix-IPV® packaging size is 18cm x 10cm x 2cm

## Packaging Change: Adacel®

This fall, Adacel® will be supplied in **10-dose single vial packs**, replacing the previous 5-dose single vial packs. During the switchover, you may receive the updated or original packaging based on stock availability and expiry date.

- Original packaging size was 7.8cm x 2.5cm x 5cm
- Updated packaging size is 7.7cm x 3.5cm x 4.2cm

A reminder that you may receive Adacel® or Boostrix® as a Tdap vaccine product. The Tdap vaccine is routinely given in Ontario to children 14-16 years of age.

As of September 8, 2025, DRHD will be **transitioning to email notification to advise when vaccine orders are ready for pick up**.
