

By-law Number 2024-041

of The Regional Municipality of Durham

Being a by-law to repeal by-law #17-2020, which provided certain delegations of authority from Regional Council to the Regional Chair and/or Regional staff (as the case may be) to ensure that the administration of the Region can rapidly respond to the challenges being experienced with the COVID-19 pandemic.

Whereas on March 28, 2022, the Region of Durham ended its emergency declaration related to the COVID-19 pandemic, and as of April 27, 2022, the Government of Ontario revoked all orders under the Reopening Ontario (A Flexible Response to COVID-19) Act, 2020, and on May 5, 2023, the World Health Organization declared an end to COVID-19 being a public health emergency;

Whereas by-law #17-2020 is effective and continuing until expressly repealed by a subsequent by-law of Regional Council; and

Whereas the delegated authorities provided in By-Law number 17-2020 have not been used since August 2022;

Now therefore, the Council of The Regional Municipality of Durham hereby enacts as follows:

1. That By-law #17-2020 is hereby repealed.
