

By-law Number 64-2023

of The Regional Municipality of Durham

Being a by-law to repeal various by-laws that have exhausted their authority or are no longer of force or effect.

Whereas Section 238(2) of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001 c, 25*, requires that every municipality shall pass a procedure by-law for governing the calling, place and proceedings of meetings.

And Whereas Procedure By-law #65-2022 authorizes the Regional Clerk, in consultation with the Regional Solicitor or their designate, to repeal by-laws that have exhausted their authority or are otherwise of no further force or effect, and shall do so by by-law.

And Whereas the Clerk has identified various by-laws for repeal for which the Regional Solicitor concurs.

Now therefore, the Regional Clerk, under the authority granted by the Council of The Regional Municipality of Durham, hereby enacts as follows:
