

BY-LAW NUMBER 04-2015
OF
THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF DURHAM

being a by-law to provide for the appointment of a community member to serve as a member of the Durham Regional Police Services Board and to provide for the paying of remuneration to the community member.

WHEREAS Section 27 (9) of the *Police Services Act*, R.S.O 1990, c.P.15, provides that the Police Services Board shall consist of one person appointed by resolution of Council, who is neither a member of the Council nor an employee of the municipality.

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 283 (1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001 c.25, as amended, the Council of the Regional Municipality of Durham may pass by-laws for paying remuneration to any person who has been appointed by the Regional Council to serve as a member of a local board.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED as a by-law of the Regional Municipality of Durham through its Council thereof as follows:

1. That Stindar Lal be appointed as of the 21st day of January 2015 as a community member to serve on the Regional Municipality of Durham Police Services Board for the term of the presently constituted Regional Council or until his successor is appointed.
2. There shall be paid to Stindar Lal, who has been appointed as a community member to serve on the Regional Municipality of Durham Police Services Board, remuneration at the rate of \$10,364.00 per annum, until his successor is appointed or he is reappointed.
3. The annual remuneration payable shall be increased by the same percentage as the general increase awarded to the Durham Regional Police Senior Officers' Association, from time to time.
4. This by-law repeals By-law 03-2011 and any amendments thereto.
