

BY-LAW NUMBER 34-2015
OF
THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF DURHAM

being a by-law to rename the portions of Regional Road No. 1, also known as Brock Road, north and south of Highway 407 from Whitevale Road to the south and to the realigned Brock Road on the north, soon to become remnant roads because of the construction of a new Brock Road by-pass in the Hamlet of Brougham.

WHEREAS Regional Council deems it desirable to rename the portion of Regional Road No. 1, also known as Brock Road from Whitevale to the southern limit of Highway 407;

AND WHEREAS Regional Council deems it desirable to rename the portion of Regional Road No. 1, also known as Brock Road from north of Highway 407 to the northern limit of realigned Regional Road No. 1, also known as Brock Road;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED as a By-law of The Regional Municipality of Durham by the Council thereof as follows:

1. That the current portion of Regional Road No. 1, also known as Brock Road, soon to become a remnant road from Whitevale Road to the southern limit of Highway 407 be named "Elsa Storry Avenue".
2. That the current portion of the Regional Road No. 1, also known as Brock Road, soon to become a remnant road from north of Highway 407 to the northern limit of realigned Regional Road No. 1, also known as Brock Road be named "Mowbray Street".
3. This by-law shall come into full force and effect on December 1st, 2015, in order to allow the City of Pickering to complete the municipal address re-numbering for the residents on the subject portions of Brock Road for which the name is to change as described in this by-law and to allow for a grace period for the residents affected to update the municipal address on their driver's license and other such documents as required.
