Summary description of the IPAC lapse:

1. Observed single-use items not discarded immediately after use.
2. Observed improper product dispensing resulting in remaining portion to be contaminated.
3. Observed unclean waxing tools stored in contaminated drawers.
4. Observed improperly cleaned (not disassembled) and improperly disinfected (not fully immersed) foot files.
5. Observed disinfectant solution contaminated with nail clippings.

IPAC Lapse Investigation

Did the IPAC lapse involve a member of a regulatory college? No

Concise description of the corrective measures required:

1. Operator to ensure all work surfaces are cleaned and disinfected immediately when visibly soiled.
2. Operator to ensure that all re-usable items are stored clean in sanitary manner and inside clean covered containers.
3. Operator to ensure single use items are discarded immediately after each use.
4. Operator to ensure proper cleaning and disinfection of all reusable implements and equipment after each use.
5. Operator to ensure all products are dispensed in manner which prevents contamination of product and remaining portion of product.
